



## Information: Before & Now. Friend or Foe?

# Natural Disasters





In conditions of a prolonged heat wave, a fire starts in a mountainous forest location. The fire breaks out in the afternoon in an extremely inaccessible area, as a result of which the Fire Department cannot immediately contain it and bring it under control.

It burns uncontrollably for a few hours and destroys a forest area, causing significant destruction while threatening the neighbouring village and an archaeological monument.

"First signs of climate change. After a record high temperature of 43 degrees Celsius, the pine forest turned to ashes."








The local community is upset. At school, you will have an opportunity to attend a presentation of the newly established General Secretariat of Forests under the Ministry of Environment and Energy (AI).



### What government agencies can do:




**Create and maintain the "fire breaks"**, these are zones where the forest and flammable vert is cleared.






Provide incentives to maintain traditional land use in agricultural and forestry systems, such as, for example, beekeeping.

Maintain the road network within the forest, such as rural roads and paths, but also provide easy access to the points
where water can be found, such as taps, water reservoirs, streams, and artificial and natural lakes.
